Jonathan's Jottings

The Comforter

Several years ago, when on a school trip, I had the privilege of going to Bayeux and seeing the famous 70-metre-long tapestry that depicts the Norman conquest of England and culminates in the battle of Hastings.

There was one particular panel of the tapestry that portrays the moment Bishop Odo, astride a horse, advances his men into battle. Alongside is the caption –
'Bishop Odo comforts his troops.'

In truth, Bishop Odo, according to academics who have long studied the tapestry, is encouraging his men who, for a time, were in danger of running from the battle. They were fearful. Yet, Bishop Odo, present with his troops, encourages them forward.

When Jesus, in John 14, told his disciples that he would send another comforter, I wonder what they thought?

What do we think of when we consider comfort or a comforter?

Maybe it is the comfort of a warm embrace, a safe place, a place where we can find rest and peace. Indeed, I believe this is true of the Holy Spirit – but I believe also that the Holy Spirit, the Comforter sent by God, is like Bishop Odo, present in our battles not affording us comfort through retreat to a safe place, but to advance with strength and courage.

May we each know this comfort of the Holy Spirit, the kind that Micah knew as he sought to declare God's word in a hostile world:

*But as for me, I am filled with power—
with the Spirit of the LORD.
Micah 3:8*
