Faith Fuel

On very few occasions, there have been times when I have failed to fill up until the needle is hovering over the red and the car tells me I have only 5 miles left in the tank. My next drive is a fraught one as I carefully observe the 'miles to empty.'

The fear of running dry has meant that this has only happened once or twice in 18 years of driving – I want to make sure there is plenty in the tank, and that my car isn't running on empty.

It begs the question; do we have the same concern for our faith? Do I show the same kind of diligence to make sure I'm not running on empty? In truth... not always!

Often times it is hard to tell that we are nearing empty until we at last find ourselves coming to a spluttering halt and wonder why. If only we had a needle to warn us when we are nearing empty... but we needn't ever get near empty. All the fuel we have need of is at hand. So how can we keep our faith fuelled?

Alongside prayer, meeting with fellow believers and breaking bread (Acts 2:42), led by the Spirit, we need to Read from God's Word and do so often. Read with regularity.

Read knowing and believing, even when it is hard to see, that God's Word is the fuel your faith needs.

Understand that, just as your breakfast will give you energy to start your day, so too will God's word establish you, refresh you and refuel you:

of his mouth more than my daily bread.
